- *Goal* of this presentation is:

To familiarize the participants with the basic principles of the Child- guided Strategies of Assessment of persons with multiple sensory disabilities, who have a developmental age <2;0 years.

Method:

1. the presenters will show the assessment (ppt)of 4 persons with multiple sensory impairment (deaf blind) , who represent a variety of issues typical for this population.

- 2. The participant will receive a copy of THE OBSERVATION WORKSHEETS as they are printed on page 159-168 of the manual *Child-guided Strategies: the Van Dijk Approach to Assessment.* (2009) American Printing House for the Blind, Inc
- 3. After presentation of CASE 1,2,3,4 the domains of the assessment are discussed with the participants and the results are written down on the Worksheets.

- *Intervention* The intervention for every individual will be discussed at the end of each presentation

- *Evaluation* . At the end of the seminar the presenter will discuss which ideas coming from the assessment will be useful for the daily practice of the participant.
